SPECIAL RULES

1. Exhibit must be grown by the exhibitor.
2. **!NEW!** Entries will be taken between 4:00 pm. and 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, August 16, 2022, and then again on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in the Exposition Building on the Arkansas Valley Fairgrounds.
3. Judging - 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 17, 2022
4. Junior or 4-H exhibitors must have separate entries for open class.
5. Unworthy exhibits may be eliminated; exhibits which do not follow class description will be disqualified.
5. Vegetables will be judged for table use. Uniformity of size, shape, and color are important.
6. Sheaves of small grain must measure 3 inches at center tie. Bundle of sorghum and alfalfa must measure 6 inches at center tie.
7. Variety of hybrid must be named in corn, sorghum, and small grains.
8. An exhibitor may not make more than one entry of the same variety in class.
9. Products must have been grown in 2021 or 2022. Exhibits may not be removed until 1:00 p.m., Sunday, August 21, 2022. All entries must be picked up by 3:00 p.m., Sunday, August 21, 2022.
11. Please pick up your ribbons between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 21, 2022, even if you don't want the produce.
